Taking care of your Sewer Network

Claredon Place, Dunblane Flooding improvements.

Further to our previous correspondence, regarding sewer network flooding improvements in Claredon Place, Dunblane, we are now able to progress with this work. On the 2 August, a site welfare facility will be set up. The 1st phase will begin on 18 August from the local Air Cadet/Bowling Club Car Park and across the B8033 roundabout. The 2nd phase will be on the opposite side of the carriage way with the start date to be advised. During this time traffic from the B8033 will be diverted up through Claredon Place before returning back on to the B8033.

When are we doing it

Mon, 2 August – set up site welfare cabins & compound – 2 weeks

Wed, 18 August – phase 1 starts at the Air Cadet/Bowling Club - 6 weeks

Wed, 27 September - progress up on the B8033 Stirling Road roundabout - for 7 weeks

We will notify you of further phases of work prior to commencement.

What this means for you

- Local traffic diversion will be set up in place, please follow signage.
- There will be further slowdown warning signs set up in Claredon Place to help keep the road safe.
- Your Water and Waste supply should not be affected.
- You will hear some construction noise, however this will be kept to a minimum where possible.
- We normally work Monday to Friday 7.30am until 5.00pm and weekends if required.

We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding while we complete this essential work.

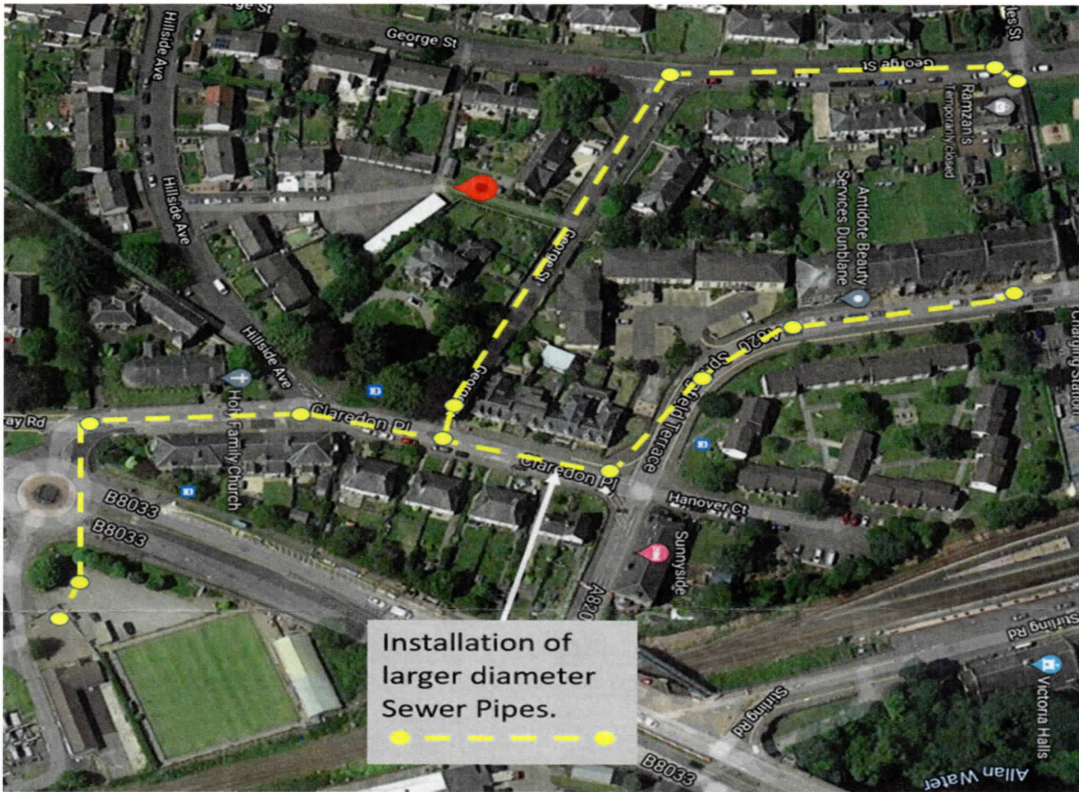

The overall planned Sewer Network improvements which will be carried out in several phases.



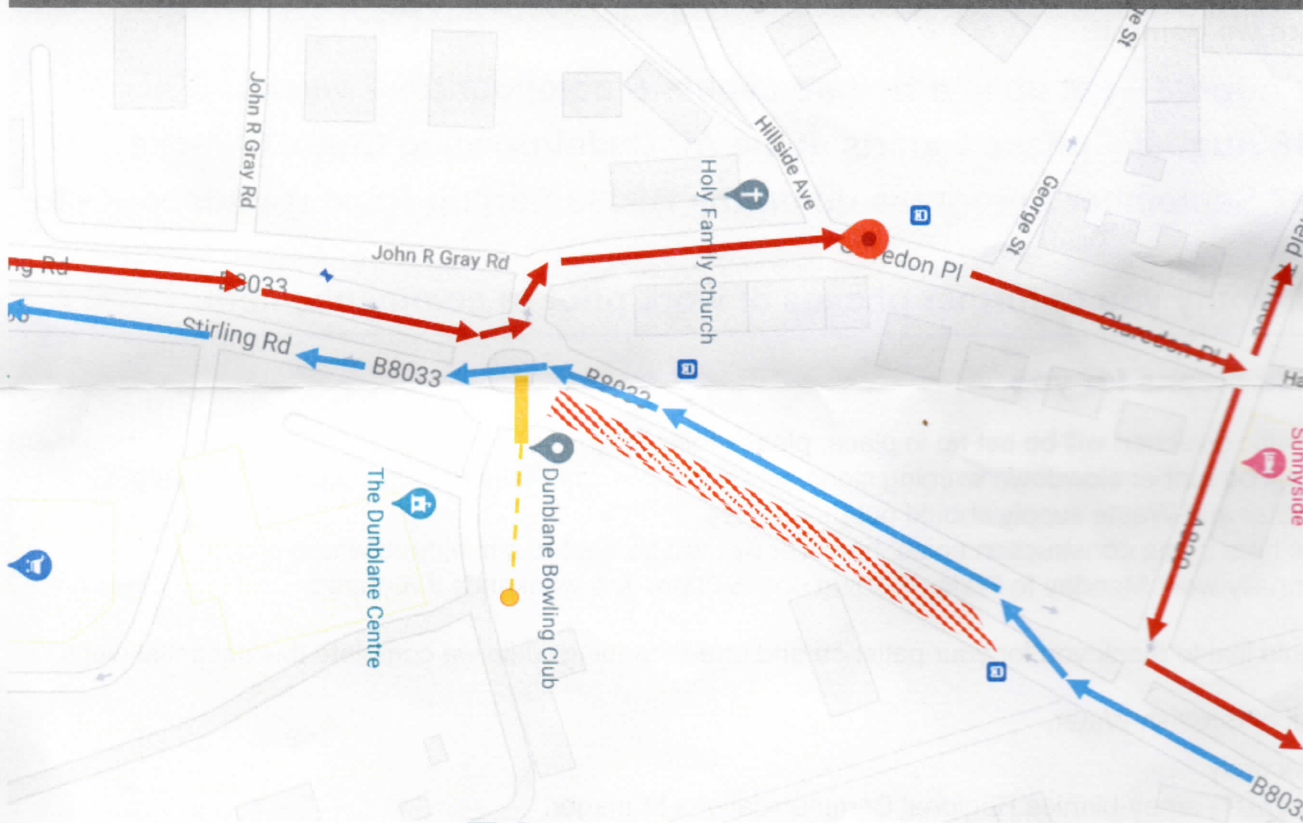
Installation of larger diameter Sewer Pipes.

The 1st Phase of works below and required traffic diversion.

Phase 1

Initially we will be working at the Air Cadet/Dunblane Bowling Club location and then up onto the roundabout marked orange on this map. Traffic will be temporarily diverted on the B8033 heading north and diverted through Claredon Place and then returning on the B8033. The work involves digging an open cut trench to lay in new sewer pipes
