Opening soon!

Yes, we can be back bowling!

Now that Government guidelines have made it possible for some sports clubs to open, the committee has put in place arrangements for limited use of the green as from next Monday, 15th June. A risk assessment has been carried out to ensure that we are complying with the regulations.

It will be great to be able to be on the green again, but there will unfortunately be limitations on the use of the green, in line with Bowls Scotland advice:

- Singles matches only, or pairs where each team is from the same household
- Informal, bounce games only, or individual practice
- A rink booking system in place, with 4 slots each day, 3 rinks per slot
- A strict regime of disinfecting equipment

Also included in this emailing are instructions about using the green. Sorry that they are so detailed, but it is important that we are all quite clear about what is required to ensure safety of us all. These instructions will also be posted on the 'Bowling and People' page of the club web site.

Hope we will all be able to benefit from having access again to the green. Do make use of it!

Booking a rink on-line

We have introduced an online rink booking system during this time of limited use of the green.

Over the next couple of days everyone receiving this newsletter will be sent an email providing a link to an online booking form.

How to book a rink:

> If you have a Google account and have downloaded the Google Sheets app then you can make an online booking yourself.

> If you don't have a Google account you can open one easily from the booking form, and download the Sheets app, so that you have access to all the online booking facilities.

> If you don't want to open a Google account you can still view the booking form to see which rinks slots are free. You can then book a rink by emailing Alex Christmas on dunblanebowlingbooking@gmail.com or by phoning him on 07482 222374.
